The Parish council recommends refusal on the grounds that the proposal is unneighbourly and does not improve or enhance the conservation area.

11/3443M Proposed demolition of existing house and garage with erection of new house Badgers Hollow

and garage.

The Parish council recommends refusal on the grounds that the proposal attacks the integrity of the original planning permission, which was to create the lock in question to resemble a "service block" and new additions to that block would destroy the concept of a development in the conservation area.

11/3458M Replacement dwelling Macclesfield Road, 02/11/11 Armstrong Farm

The Parish Council recommends refusal of this application. The Council was alarmed and dismayed to read the report attached to this application which refers to demolition of 90 % of the existing property, and that this was discussed with the Conservation Officer. Examination of the previous approved applications 10/0629 and 08/1286 only refer to demolition of a single storey extension, with alterations and extensions to the existing property!

The Officer's report attached to 10/0629 says 'the proposed amendments would not have a detrimental impact on residential amenity or the character of the existing building'; also 'No objections have been received from the Conservation Officer'. The PC would like an explanation as to how this can be interpreted to allow demolition of the majority of a significant 'Heritage asset' (CE words), and how we can be considering an application to demolish the rest?

Armstrong Farm was a building of significant architectural merit given that it was one of the oldest farms on the Edge, dating back hundreds of years. and is on the list of Locally Important Buildings. That work such as this has been allowed by CE is a scandal, and is, in the opinion of the PC worthy of Judicial Review
